Ninth Annual Double Dollar Rope, Ranch and Trail Horse Sale Sets High Marks During 2007 Wrangler National Finals

Four Young Geldings Raise the Bar

What began in 1999 with 17 finished Double Dollar roping horses, a small band of brood mares, prospects and three consignors, has evolved over the last nine years to feature 110 roping horses, 80 ranch and trail horses, brood mares, and future prospects from the Double Dollar Ranch, along with over 50 consignors. Total sales from the event were over \$1.5 million with over 5,000 people in attendance during the two day sale.

Topping the sale were four young geldings, with the highest sale going to Colonel Concho Villa, a grandson of Colonels Freckles, consigned by Siggins Horse Company and bought by Xavier Cortez. Colonel Concho Villa topped the sale at \$80,000 making him the highest selling horse in the history of the Double Dollar Sale. World renowned auctioneer, Kevin O'Callaghan conducted the record breaking sale.
